*Los Angeles*-class fast attack submarine USS *Alexandria* (SSN-757) returns to Naval Base Point Loma, San Diego, on 18 May following a six-month deployment to the western Pacific. Commissioned on 29 June 1991, the boat is more than 360-ft long and displaces more than 6900-tons. *Alexandria* is capable of supporting various missions, including anti-submarine warfare, anti-surface warfare, strike warfare, and intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance.
