Arleigh Burke-class guided-missile destroyer USS *John S. The tremendous amount of damage inflicted to the USS *Fitzgerald* is well-portrayed in this view of the starboard side of the destroyer. The Arleigh Burke-class guided-missile destroyer (DDG-62) was photographed on 17 June returning to Fleet Activities (FLEACT) Yokosuka following the disastrous collision with a Japanese cargo container ship that was heading out of Yokosuka, Japan. Suffering extremely severe damage, the destroyer managed to return under her own power. However, at press time the bodies of seven sailors had been recovered from the flooded portions of the damaged ship. (USN/Peter Burhart)
